II. Announcements and Guidelines

1. Things to bring

- a. Toiletry and changing clothes, including a light weight jacket
- b. Hymnal, Bible, note book and this conference handbook
- c. Pillows, blankets and towels will be provided for each prepaid bed
- d. Each building has a small refrigerator and microwave for your convenience.
- e. A microwave oven is available in the public area on each floor.
- f. A refrigerator is available in the activity room in each building. Parents who need to store their children's dairy products (such as milk) can use it.

2. Special attention: We will be using different meeting halls, cafeteria and dorms this time. Therefore, please read carefully various designations on the campus map.

3. Transportation and Parking:

- a. Coordinate with your church leaders for your transportation need
- b. If you need to commute daily, please notify us in advance so we can provide you meal tickets and the parking permit.

4. Registration:

- a. **Registration** begins at 2:30 pm on the first day (8/31/2018)
- b. **Keys: Two keys** for each person (one for the building entrance and one for your room). No key will be given to children 12 or under. Please return all keys to the school office upon your departure. Penalty for the lost key is \$10 for that of the building entrance and \$50 for the room. Please do NOT give your keys to your child to minimize the risk of losing them.
- c. **Parking:** Please cut off the temporary unloading permit at the end of this handbook and place it on your dash board. After check in, please replace it with the permanent parking permit received at check-in AND park your car in **Lot #2**. Please see the enclosed map for details. Any ticket you receive due to non-compliance with the aforementioned instruction is your own responsibility. UCSB offers NO grace period.
- d. **Meals:** A wrist and will be issued at check-in, please wear it at meal time.
- e. **Interim Departure:** If you need to leave before the conclusion of conference, please check out at the school office personally.

5. Meetings:

- a. Refer to the conference schedule for various meeting schedules.
- b. Preview the scriptures in this handbook prior to each meeting
- c. At each meeting , arrive during the prayer time and pray. Do not chat with others or attend to other things. Prepare your heart to meet the Lord.

- d. Please bring your own hymn book, or borrow one from the conference if you do not have one. You can keep it during the conference period, but please return it at the end of the conference.
- e. Please follow the instruction of ushers regarding seating, generally from the front and center rows.

6. Living Logistics

- a. Do not change room on your own. Please bring all your logistic needs to Wendy Wangs' attention during reasonable hours.
- b. Morning devotion will be led by and at a location designated by respective group leaders. Devotion materials are included in this handbook.
- c. Please strictly adhere to the attached conference schedule. Please keep quiet during the free time immediately after lunch and during the bed time.
- d. To ensure your safety, when traveling outside of our living and meeting quarter, please go in pairs or more.
- e. Walking on bicycle paths is NOT allowed and can result in serious injuries to pedestrians and bicyclists.
- f. All exterior doors will remain locked 24 hours a day. Guests should carry their keys with them at all times.
- g. Furniture in bedrooms must returned to its original position when you check out. Pool tables in the recreation rooms must NOT be moved. Furniture in community spaces or bedrooms should not be moved from their location.

7. Offerings:

- a. **This Conference is made possible by faith. Let us look up to the Lord for his provision.**
- b. The number of total attendants is 202, and the estimated expenses total \$58,000. The registration fee of \$100 covers partially our needs. Therefore, please continue to offer as the Holy Spirit leads you. We believe that the Lord will provide for us.

- d. For offerings made for a purpose other than the conference, please clearly label it and drop it in the offering box. Otherwise, all offerings not specifically designated will be applied to the conference expenses.
- e. Preliminary financial report will be given verbally on the last day of the conference.

8. Meals

- a. Please arrive at the dining hall 10 minutes prior to the scheduled time.
- b. Please act promptly when choosing your food so all do not have to wait in line too long.

9. Book Sale

UCSB parking permit must be displayed on vehicle at all times.
 Permit dispensers throughout campus sell short-term permits at all times. The Parking Sales Office in Building 381 off Stadium Road sells permits during business hours. Payment by credit card and cash is accepted.
 A short-term permit entitles you to Visitor parking status. Please ensure that you park in a space or lot allowed by your permit type as parking violations are subject to citation. Do not park in spaces marked "RESTRICTED at All Times", "Reserved" or "Restricted" without an appropriate permit.
 What do the lot colors mean?

- Green** Student parking allowed at all times. Visitor parking is restricted Friday-Saturday from Midnight to 5:00 am
- Yellow** No visitor or student parking Monday to Friday between 7:30 AM and 5:00 PM. Visitor and student parking allowed at other times. Individual spaces within lots may have restrictions.
- Blue** No staff, visitor or student parking in 15 Parking Monday to Friday between 7:30 AM and 5:00 PM.
- Orange** No visitor or student parking (except Disabled) at any time.
- Red** Residence Hall student parking at all times. Each location requires its own H permit.

VI. Freeway Direction

Location : **UC Santa Barbara - Santa Rosa Hall** (Santa Rosa Hall is located on UCEN Road.)

You can try entering Santa Rosa Hall, Isla Vista, CA 93117 in google maps or they can also try 34.411076, -119.845282 in GPS.

Southbound 101: Exit the 101 freeway at the Los Carneros Road off-ramp (approximately eleven miles north of Santa Barbara) and then turn right. Head south and take a left on Mesa Road. Follow Mesa Road until the roundabout, then make a right for Lagoon Rd. Then, take the first right at the stop sign onto UCEN Road. Santa Rosa Hall will be the second residence hall on your left across from the Psychology building.

Northbound 101: Exit the 101 freeway at the Airport / UCSB (Route 217) off-ramp (approximately eight miles north of Santa Barbara) and proceed through the Henley Gate at the east campus entrance. Continue straight through the roundabout onto Lagoon Rd. Then, take the first right at the stop sign onto UCEN Road. Santa Rosa Hall will be the second residence on your left across from the Psychology building.

Parking Permit

Please cut off the temporary unloading permit at the end of this handbook and place it on your dash board. After check in, please replace it with the permanent parking permit received at check-in AND park your car in **Lot #2**.

Quick note to mention that in order to park in Lot 2, you need to drive through Lot 9, which is in the middle of Anacapa & Santa Rosa Halls. You may add if you wish to the directions below.

During arrival, you can park in any spot in surrounding parking lots as long as it's not one of those designated on the unloading permit. They should make sure they have that with them, please. Spots like "faculty only" or metered and vendor spaces are not allowed.
