Scriptures: Matthew 2:4-6, 23; John: 18: 1-9; Acts 2: 22-28, 3: 3-10, 10:38-44, 22:3-15

- I. The Lord Was Closely Connected to Three Places While He Was on Earth:
 1. The honorable man from “Bethlehem”
 2. The wonderful man of “Galilee”
 3. The might man of “Nazareth” – the Lord loved to call himself Nazarene
- II. The Great Victory in Garden of Gethsemane by Jesus the Nazarene
- III. Jesus of Nazarene Performed Marvelous Signs and Wonders among You
- IV. In the Name of Jesus the Nazarene, the Church Entered into the Era of the Holy Spirit
- V. God Anointed Jesus the Nazarene as well as the Church with Holy Spirit and Power

Message II The Kingship of Jesus of Nazareth

Scriptures: Matthew 2: 1-2, 6, 4: 1-11, 8: 5-11, 12: 38-42, 17: 1-3, 21: 1-11, 12-17, 42-46;
John 18: 35-37; Acts: 1: 1-3, 3: 1-10, 4: 9-12, 28: 20-21

- I. The One That Comes from the House of Bread will Feed My People of Israel
- II. The Warfare between the Kingdom of Heaven and the Kingdom of Darkness
- III. The Lord is the Greatest King
- IV. Who is the True King – Jesus of Nazareth vs Pilate
 1. The Nazarene was the least likely king, but only he was the true king
 2. It was Jesus of Nazareth that judged Pilate
- V. His Kingship Is Revealed in Jerusalem and Zion – He is the Greater Solomon
 1. The Lord wants to use it (the colt) – His kingship is revealed on the ones whose inner eyes are opened
 2. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord
- VI. Form the Lips of Children and Infants You Have Ordained Praise
- VII. The Sign of The Fig Tree and the Power to Move a Mountain- “My house will be called a house of prayer for all nations”
